# Council Summaries

## October 28, 2024 - Regular Council Meeting

The October 28, 2024, Regular Council Meeting was called to order at 7 PM in Council Chambers at the Town Office in White City. Highlights from the meeting included a presentation by Mr. Jose Lebioada on behalf of Tell Properties Ltd., the Consent Agenda comprised of the September 2024 financial statements and the approval and ratification of accounts and payroll. Departmental reports covered activities like bylaw reviews, mock council sessions, municipal election preparations, council orientation, and CSO availability scheduling. Under new business, Council approved an amendment to the Municipal Donations, Grant, and Sponsorship Policy. In the bylaws section, Bylaw No. 710-24, the Community Standards Bylaw Amendment, was approved following three readings.

During the roundtable, Council discussed upcoming White Butte Museum and RCMP stakeholder meetings as well as the latest Youth Advisory Committee meeting. The meeting concluded with a closed session at 9:15 PM to address confidential municipal operations, with no further resolutions passed.

## November 25, 2024 - Regular Council Meeting

The November 25, 2024 Regular Council Meeting was called to order at 7PM in Council Chamber at the Town Office in White City. Council accepted the agenda, and no conflicts of interest were declared. The declaration of election results was presented and approved. Council also approved the consent agenda, which included minutes from the October 28 Regular Council Meeting, accounts and payroll, and the October 2024 financial statements and bank reconciliation for approval. The Town Manager provided a report with updates on the Wastewater Management Authority project, community planning, and an upcoming community group presentation by the Mayor and Town Manager. Discussions also included grant funding for the Wastewater Management Authority and clarification of a bylaw enforcement matter.

In new business, Council confirmed new committee and board appointments following the 2024 Municipal Election. The appointment of a Deputy Mayor was deferred to the December 16 Regular Council Meeting. Updates from various committees were shared, including the White Butte Regional Emergency Measures Organization, Youth Advisory Committee, and Recreation Advisory Committee. The meeting concluded with a closed session on the 2025 Annual Budget, ending at 9:30 PM.



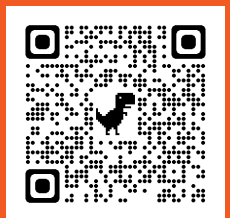

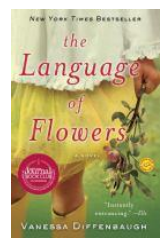

## Upcoming Projects

Public Works staff have been busy preparing for the forthcoming cold months. In addition to keeping our roadways clear of snow, they are also working hard to get the outdoor rinks up and running, and stringing up the Christmas lights around town. Public Works is also continuing to trim trees along walking trails and alley ways.

With the snow making its arrival in November, Public Works would like to remind residents to place their bins 6 inches (or so) off the asphalt edge on your property. The Loraas truck has a lift arm that reaches up to 9 feet! No need to worry about the truck not being able to reach. This small adjustment greatly helps our Public Works department more efficiently clear snow.

Another reminder regarding snow removal, we ask that residents refrain from blowing or shoveling snow from your property onto public roads. This can lead to a buildup of ice, making roads more dangerous.
